



Driver license applicants who have a **junior learner permit (class DJ or MJ)** must give this completed certificate to the Motor Vehicle License Examiner at every road test. Applicants must have driven at least 50 hours with supervision, which includes 15 hours after sunset. The number of hours driven with supervision in a certified Driver Education Course is considered part of the required 50 hours and can be certified below.

NOTE TO THE PARENT OR GUARDIAN OF A JUNIOR DRIVER: You can remove the consent you gave when the junior driver described above submitted an application for a driver permit or driver license. To cancel the junior driver's class DJ or MJ permit or driver license, complete form MV-1W (Withdrawal of Consent) and submit the form to DMV.

For Your Road Test: Bring your original Pre-Licensing Course Certificate (MV-278) or Student Certificate of Completion (MV-285). Copies are not acceptable. Bring your completed Certification of Supervised Driving (MV-262), if you are under age 18, completed by your parent or guardian. Bring a driver over the age of 18 (if driving the vehicle to the test site) or over the age of 21 (if accompanying the permit-holder to the test site). In either situation, the other driver must have a physical driver's license that is valid to operate the test vehicle. Bring a vehicle to drive during the test that has a valid registration and inspection, operates properly, and is in clean condition. If driving a rental vehicle, you must provide the rental agreement and written permission authorizing use of the vehicle for the road test. Only the accompanying driver of the vehicle is allowed at the road test site (no other passengers are allowed). Bring your photo learner permit. If you have an interim or temporary learner permit without a photo, you must also show a NYS photo driver license or a NYS non-driver photo ID card. Photo documents from other states are not acceptable.

CERTIFICATION

I certify that I am the parent/guardian or representative of a government agency or facility. I also certify that the applicant has **completed at least 50 hours** of supervised driving, including 15 hours after sunset. I understand that some or all of the required supervised driving hours may have been completed with a licensed driving school instructor or driver education teacher, and that these hours may be certified below. I certify that any supervised driving hours that were not completed with a licensed driving school instructor or driver education teacher were completed: 1) under the immediate supervision of a person at least 21 years of age who holds a license that is valid in New York State to operate the type of vehicle that was used, and 2) in compliance with any regional restrictions applicable to driving with a junior learner permit in that area. I understand that falsifying any information on this certification may be a crime (felony or misdemeanor), punishable by a fine, imprisonment, or both.
